ABOUT US: The Blood Center of Brazos Valley is an affiliate of Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center, serving nine Brazos Valley counties - Brazos, Burleson, Fayette, Grimes, Leon, Madison, Milam, Walker and Washington. The Blood Center of Brazos Valley is asking its donors to Commit for Life. It takes three simple steps: 1) Donate once per quarter; 2) allow The Blood Center to contact you; and 3) spread the word, encouraging others to Commit for Life. Donors must be at least 17 years of age, weigh a minimum of 110 pounds and be in good general health.
