I hope this message finds you well.

As we conclude the first quarter of 2025, we want to express our sincere gratitude for your unwavering support and collaboration in ensuring the safety and well-being of our community. Our partnership reflects our shared commitment to saving and sustaining lives.

We wanted to provide an update regarding the current regional inventory of blood products. Our in-house and hospital inventory levels for red blood cells, platelets, and plasma remain at optimal levels. The only exception is O-negative red cells, which are currently at minimal levels. Despite this, we continue to fulfill all standing orders and respond to emergency needs without disruption.

We recognize that many regional blood centers across the country may be facing challenges in meeting their supply needs, which could lead to conflicting messages about blood availability. Our ongoing efforts to monitor and adjust inventory levels are critical to ensuring that our hospital partners are prepared to address both routine and emergency patient needs. We will continue to assess and manage the supply closely to maintain this standard of care.
